



NEW Competition Event on 14 March, the International Day of Mathematics

MathTriathlon 2020

The Cyprus Mathematical Society and the THALES Foundation announces the hosting of the competition event “*MathTriathlon 2020*” at EUROMATH & EUROSCIENCE 2020 conference.

MathTriathlon is an innovative Mathematical competition that requires having a growth mindset and collaboration skills in order to complete certain tasks assigned to the participating teams. Individual skills are equally as important as team communication and cooperation skills. The competition consists of three Math Games (it is a triathlon after all) that the teams need to complete to the best extent possible: MathRelay, MathBattle and MathSpeed.

Create a team of 3 students and compete against other teams in order to win the MathTriathlon!

Registration Rules

- The Math-triathletes do not have to necessarily be from the same school or even country.
- The students have to strictly be **12** years old and above (grade 7 and above). Not all team members have to be the same age. Age doesn't matter so much, it's the **Mathletic spirit** that counts!
