HALF DAY TOUR TO PAPHOS



After breakfast, the guests will visit the **Tombs of the Kings** which are underground tombs carved out of solid rock date back to the 3rd century. High officials and kings were buried there. At the downtown area of the city of Paphos, the guests will have a chance to visit the **Archaeological Park** which includes the “House of Dionysos” while also the ‘House of Theseus’, a place where the guests will admire a series of beautifully preserved mosaics depicting scenes from the Greek Mythology. Also, during their tour in Paphos, our guests will have an opportunity to visit the place where according to Christianity Saint Paul was tied on a Collum and tortured by the Romans, when he visited Cyprus to preach Christianity. Last stop will be at Yeroskipou Village, where one of the oldest churches in Cyprus that dates back to 9th Century A.D, stands in the Center of the village’s square. Sightseeing of Ayia Paraskevi Church before departing back to the Hotel.

FULL DAY TOUR TO LIMASSOL / KOURION



First visit the **Cyprus Medieval Museum** is housed in the Medieval Castle of Limassol with exhibits that include Medieval pottery, tombstones, superb silver Byzantine era plates, weapons, crosses and coins. The castle itself was built in the 13th century on the site of an earlier Byzantine castle near the town’s old harbor. According to archaeological sources, the castle was much larger in its original form, with the Venetians making many modifications to it so that it could be used in the defenses of the town, with its walls strengthened to ward off sea-pirates. Legend has it that Richard the Lionheart – the King of England and leader of the 3rd Crusade – landed near Amathus on his way to the Holy Land and celebrated his marriage to Berengaria of Navarre in the castle’s chapel in 1191, crowning her Queen of England. In 1570 the Ottomans conquered the castle and used it as a garrison and jail. During British Rule it functioned as a police station, and briefly as a place of detainment. Next visit will be at Ancient City of **Kourion**. Located on the outskirts of Limassol, Kourion is considered to be one of the most important Archaeological sites all over Cyprus, as it was one of the 11 cities that were established by the surviving Myceneans from Argos Peloponnesus, that found refuge in Cyprus around the 12th BCE. Today, amongst other excavation, Kourion holds the 4th Century AD House of Efstolios – an estate that has extraordinary Proto-Christian mosaics, along with the Roman-styled baths where the ancient floor heating system is still visible to this day. Furthermore, during the Kourion tour, the group will have an opportunity sightseeing the Ancient Greek Theatre that was constructed at the end of the 2nd BCE, during the Ptolemy rule over the island and it’s still in use, where every summer the Department of Antiquity in association with the Cypriot Theatrical Organization organizes ancient Greek tragedy and comedy theatrical plays. On the way back to hotel, last stop will be at the **Aphrodite’s Rock (Petra tou Romiou)**. It’s one of the most beautiful coastlines of the island with a huge rock on the edge. According to the mythology, the Goddess of Love and Beauty, Aphrodite, was born from the foam of the sea at this spot on one of the rocks near the coastline.
